

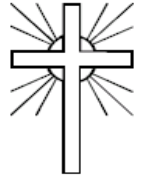

News from the Gardens at All Saints

Everyone knows that allotments and chickens go together, so in December we introduced our four hens, **Bridie, Sally, Susie and Winnie** to the Parish. They live next to the vegetable garden and if you go round the back of Church after Mass you will see them scratching, pecking and having fun.

In April we were asked to take care of **two orphan baby wild rabbits** and they came to live in a hutch and run near the chickens. The plan was to avoid taming them and just feed them until they were big enough to fend for themselves in the wild. They grew fast and soon dug themselves an escape tunnel. We thought they had gone to seek their fortune but a few days later there they were again, scampering on the field and nibbling the new flowers. They come each morning and evening to see the hens and share their food.

Word must have got around that we are kind to animals at All Saints because on Tuesday this week we were visited by a **Sika Deer doe and her fawn**. We thought we were seeing things when they appeared, all sleek and beautiful in the sunshine. We couldn't provide the running streams the deer seeks in Psalm 42 but we did give them a bucket of water!

We have **our first beehive now** and are looking forward to making friends with local beekeepers. If anyone in the Parish keeps bees it would be great if they could give some help and support. Of course help and advice is always welcome in the gardens with lots of jobs to do. I am there most days at different times but almost always on Tuesday and Saturday afternoons. Or leave me your number at the back of Church and I will contact you.
