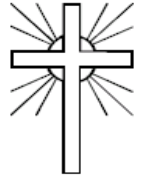

AN INVITATION FROM BISHOP PATRICK MCKINNEY - Bishop Patrick has echoed the Pope's challenge by saying; **'This is an exciting opportunity to help prepare our parishes for the work of evangelisation in our diocese.'**

In the Year of Mercy and in response to Proclaim 15, the Bishop has invited the CaFE team to run a pilot GIFT course over two Saturdays, 22nd October 2016 and 5th November 2016 (both to be attended) at Trinity School, Aspley, Nottingham NG8 3EZ. Each day will begin at 10am and finish at 3pm with Mass on the second afternoon. Bishop Patrick is encouraging all parishes to send **several potential course leaders** to experience this simple tool of faith renewal.
