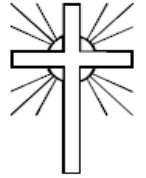

Closure of the Jubilee of Mercy: The doors of mercy in all our parishes and the holy doors in Mount St Bernard Abbey, Holy Cross Priory, Leicester and the Briars Catholic Youth Retreat Centre will be closed on Sunday 13th November 2016.

There will be a Mass celebrated on Sunday 20th November 2016, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe at 6 pm in St Barnabas' Cathedral; everyone is very welcome to this Mass.
