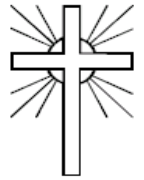

Sunday 9th April 2017

Let us enter together into the moving liturgies of the Sacred Triduum, and be with Jesus through his passion and death, culminating into the light overcoming the darkness at the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday! (FG)

Adult Stations of the Cross – 7.30pm, St Mary Crowned Church.

Easter Vigil **9.00pm, All Saints Church**

Mass of Chrism – Wednesday 12th April 11.30 am, St Barnabas' Cathedral Nottingham. Renewal of Religious/Priestly Vows by all Diocesan Deacons and Priests, & blessing of the Sacred Oils by Bishop Patrick McKinney to be used in every parish throughout the Diocese for the Sacraments. All are welcome, but I advise you to get there early to ensure a seat! (FG)

We had a wonderful Deanery Lenten Station Mass this week at St Anne's Buxton. Bishop Patrick announced that "He had a Priest in mind, and that he would be coming to Buxton during the 3rd week in May" (FG)
