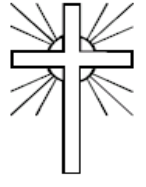

With regards to the Eucharistic Congress (Adoremus).

This event is open to anyone who wishes to go, however there is a cost implication of £40 for the Saturday. The event in Liverpool is over 3 days 7th – 9th September and I would encourage and support anyone who is interested in attending to let me know asap as names have to be submitted.

The Saturday is the main day and is scheduled to happen in The Echo Arena in Liverpool - which can accommodate 10,000 pilgrims - will be the home to a six-hour stage programme, which will include a Congress Mass, keynote speakers including Bishop Robert Barron, an excellent speaker, and a drama highlighting the beauty of reverence and devotion.

The day will conclude with Adoration. I have to submit names for this event so please register your interest asap.

The final day (Sunday 9th September) there will be a Procession through the city, (no ticket is needed). If you are interested in going, please tell me and I am thinking that if there are enough people we could get a coach and travel together to Liverpool.

The Restoration team write:

- The major underpinning work at Royle House has been rescheduled for the Spring.
- St Mary's Hall roof is now completed.
- Re-roofing the candle room, prayer room and sacristy corridor is scheduled to commence this coming week (w/b 23rd October)
- We are still in the process of getting quotes for the re-roofing of the apse at St Mary's and once these have been agreed, work will commence as soon as possible.
- Quotes have now been agreed for the repair of the coping stones at the front of the church and scaffolding is due to be erected by 31st October with the repair starting shortly afterwards.
- A paint specialist from the Historic Churches Commission is visiting St Mary's on 24th October to examine the existing paintwork.
- The sale of St Mary's Presbytery is in progress.

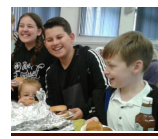
