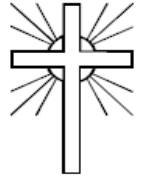

Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018

**The Holy Father's prayer intention for the month of May** is Evangelisation and the mission of the laity – That the lay faithful may fulfil their specific mission, by responding with creativity to the challenges that face the world today.

**Holy Day of Obligation** – A timely reminder that Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> May is the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, and is a Holy Day of Obligation.

There will be a 10am Mass at St Mary Crowned Church with the schools, and a 7pm Mass in the evening at All Saints. (FG)

**As announced last week** "Pope Francis has issued a long apostolic exhortation on holiness in today's world, in which he emphasizes the universal call to sanctity, highlights the pitfalls to achieving it, and recalls that the Christian life is one of constant battle against the devil and the forces of evil.

**Gaudete et Exsultate (Rejoice and Be Glad) — The Call to Holiness in Today's World** — contains many themes the Holy Father has repeated over the past five years: an emphasis on the importance of discernment, warnings against Gnosticism and neo-Pelagianism, rigidity, doing things as they have always

been done, an excessive emphasis on doctrine, **and gossip**. The document is rich in guidance on how to answer the call to holiness in a world filled with distractions, consumerism and hedonism. Frequently, the Pope stresses the importance of prayer and worship, but gives greater emphasis to acts of love and mercy toward one's neighbour, especially the poor and those on the periphery."
