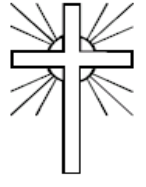

Sunday 6th May 2018

Holy Day of Obligation – Thursday 10th May is the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, and is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be a 10am Mass at St Mary Crowned Church with the schools, and a 7pm Mass in the evening at All Saints. (FG)

Bishop Patrick has asked us all to say this prayer daily:

Prayer for Peace

Let us pray, through the intercession of Mary Queen of Peace, for peace on earth and an end to violence and terrorism in our world,

For a new spirit of trust and collaboration between nations,

For the gift of wisdom for our politicians and leaders,

And for the resolution of long-standing conflicts in Syria, Gaza and the Ukraine, and in other countries around the world.

Thank you to the flower teams in both Churches who work so hard to ensure that our Churches are beautifully decorated with flowers during the year. Should you wish, please contribute to the Church flowers by placing an envelope in the collection.

St Bernadette witnessed to flowers being at the feet of "the beautiful lady" when she appeared to her by the river, in a cave in Lourdes in 1858. This led to flowers being laid at Marian shrines all over Europe. **Let us continue to reclaim the outdoors Marian Shrines with flowers.** In Thanksgiving to Mary for prayers answered, place flowers at our shrines in both Churches.

May is the month of Mary! I invite parishioners to come together 20 minutes before the weekday Masses in the great prayer of the Rosary, that most stable of Catholic devotions. Also to pray The Memorare (page 350 – parish mass books) at the conclusion of prayers of the faithful/Bidding Prayers. (FG)
