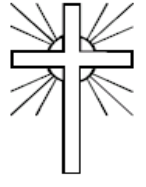

Thoughts from today's Second Reading: Cor 12: 7-10

We are near the end of Paul's writing to the Corinthians. He knows many of them criticise him for being ambitious and for being weak, and he has spent the whole of chapter eleven defending and praising himself - to establish his right to be an apostle. *Suddenly he stops.* His boasting has reminded him of his weaknesses and failures.

God, who had not wanted him to become proud, allowed weaknesses to overcome him so that he would rely upon God's grace and not his own strength.

Scholars have wondered about Paul's "thorn in the flesh" and have suggested malaria, epilepsy, disease of the eyes - besides the spiritual weakness of never feeling secure, knowing the possibility of failure, remembering his persecution of Christians.

Here, as elsewhere, Paul acknowledges the divine plan for human weakness to lead us to trust in God and not in ourselves.
