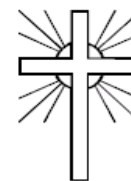

Thoughts from today's Gospel Reading: Mark 7: 31-37

Just before today's reading Mark tells of Jesus making a long journey north-west to the coastal region. There he heals the daughter of a pagan woman, responding to her extraordinary faith, and now he makes the return journey to the south of the Sea of Galilee.

There is another healing, fully detailed, and separate healing of ears and tongue.

Jesus tells the witnesses to tell no one of what they have seen. That seems impossible - just as at every time he asks for secrecy in Mark's Gospel. People are bound to share good news. This "Messianic Secret" is characteristic of Mark's Gospel and we have no convincing explanation of it beyond Jesus' humility. It is God, who gives healing - acting through Jesus.
