Thoughts from today's Gospel Reading, Jn 16:12-15

The Last Supper discourse occupies chapters 14-17 of John's Gospel. It is extraordinarily beautiful.

Jesus speaks to the apostles, to the disciples and to his heavenly Father.

He gives assurances, makes promises, utters warnings, preaches truth, challenges the disciples' limited understanding, warns against the world and its values, and promises the Holy Spirit.

We marvel at the mind(s) of whoever wrote this Gospel. It is beyond a feat of memory: this is a recreation of the words at the Last Supper, a vivid imagining of the mind of Christ and an overwhelming insight into Jesus' short ministry – doomed to end that same evening in the Garden of Gethsemane.

Who would dare attempt such a recreation but someone who knew and loved the Lord, prayed for guidance to be faithful to the memory of the Supper (whether actually present or not) and bold enough to speak and meditate in the person of Christ?

Today's reading answers our question: in the Holy Spirit, promised in Jesus' words, all truth will be revealed.
