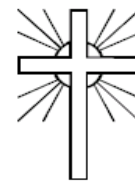

SERVICE FOR THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND

A service for our sick and housebound parishioners will be celebrated in St Mary's Hall on Sunday 24th November at 2.30 pm. The service is expected to last no more than half an hour, and people of any denomination are equally welcome to participate.
