



## Celebration Mass for the re-opening of St Mary's

As this newsletter went to press, we were all looking forward eagerly to the re-opening of St Mary Crowned this weekend. I know I'm not alone in my admiration and gratitude for the sterling efforts of Fr Greg and the past and present members of the Glossop Parishes Maintenance Committee: the completion of the first phase of the project is a testament to the way that they have planned and overseen this project, in liaison with diocesan authorities, professional advisers and contractors. Heartfelt thanks too to those people whose wonderful generosity has made the work possible.

***It will be a joy to welcome Fr Greg and Bishop Patrick to join us in the celebration of the Vigil Mass at St Mary Crowned for the Feast of Our Lady's Birthday.*** Bishop Patrick will be the principal celebrant, at 7pm on Tuesday. Light refreshments (hygienically pre-packaged for your safety!) will be served in St Mary's Hall after Holy Mass.

Ample parking will be available at St Philip Howard School, via the lane opposite St Mary's Hall.

*Fundraising continues towards phase two of the works, and as you will have read in recent issues of this newsletter, some very generous donations have been made by people eager to see the job finished, so that an enclosed area for refreshments and meetings can be installed along with adequate lavatory facilities, to better fit the church for bringing to fruit our aspiration for our Glossop parishes to more missionary and outward-looking, with greater involvement in community life.*

There's still a long way to go before we have enough money to start phase two, and every donation, however large or small, is most welcome.

**Parish Safeguarding Procedures – DBS Forms**

As we open to more activities within our church communities, it is essential to ensure that all volunteers have an up-to-date DBS certificate.

Volunteer roles include: Catechists, Children's liturgy helpers, Extraordinary ministers, Visitors, Drivers and General helpers, anyone who comes into contact with children and vulnerable adults.

Volunteer duties must be covered by a diocesan DBS certificate even if the volunteer has a certificate from another role such as their employment.
