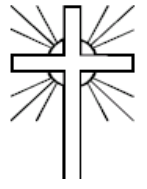

## **A Message from Bishop Patrick:**

### ***Act of Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary***

In the light of the current crisis unfolding in Ukraine, Pope Francis will lead an Act of Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary this coming Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> March, the Solemnity of the Annunciation. Bishop Patrick will do the same at the end of the 1pm Mass at St Barnabas' Cathedral. Children in schools and the housebound, who are able, are invited to pray the rosary (or a part of it) that day, so that everyone can be in prayerful solidarity with Pope Francis and the situation facing the people of Ukraine and Russia.
