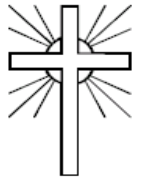

## Next weekend -

### We welcome Bishop Patrick to our community

Bishop Patrick will celebrate Mass with us next Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> July at All Saints Church at 6pm, for the commemoration of 180 years of continual Catholic worship; and also the following morning at 9.30am at St Mary Crowned Church for the 130-year commemoration of the foundation stone being laid.

### Thoughts on today's First Reading: Isaiah 66 : 10-14

The wonderful Book of Isaiah is in three parts: (1) chapters 1-39, by the prophet himself; (2) 40-55, the Book of Consolation, written perhaps two centuries later; (3) a collection of writings by later disciples of Isaiah.

Today's reading comes from this final section and was written after the rebuilding of the Temple:

It speaks of the glory of Jerusalem filled with the presence of God.

Read all the beautiful poem, vv.5-16, and wonder at the vivid image of God's causing a new people to be born - and the rejoicing that we are invited to share for the mother Jerusalem.

Jerusalem is mother of the people of God but also the glory of all nations, and the vision is of a peaceful procession of the peoples of the world coming to share God's love for the Holy Land and Jerusalem.

We are reminded of the visit of the Magi to Bethlehem (Matthew 2:11) and the verses of Isaiah which "prophecy" that visit (Isaiah 60:1-6).

### Thought for the Week:

*"We Will Remember Them"*

The events of the week have included the commemoration of those who gave their lives for us and for our freedom as a nation in the Battle of the Somme, 100 years ago.

A British Soldier, waiting to go into the battle wrote -

*"You lose your sense of fear  
when thinking about other people.."*

St Paul wrote in his letter to the Romans:

*"Love one another, with mutual affection, outdo one another in showing honour.."*
