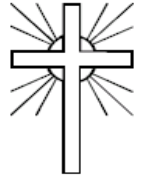

***This Mass of healing involves the ancient rite of firstly praying over the sick, invoking the comfort of God's Holy Spirit, then the anointing of the head for the healing of the mind, and finishing with the anointing of the hands for the healing of the body.***

You can receive this Sacrament as often as you wish, and it is a source of great comfort for us all. Additionally, all our sins are forgiven when we receive this Sacrament, so you don't need to go to confession but can rejoice in leaving the Church in a state of grace.

### **News from St Philip Howard Catholic Academy:**

Last week the school remembered those who had fallen during acts of war, focusing on the two world wars. Pupils had special assemblies led by our Head of Humanities, Mrs Kernohan. They looked at the heartache of war & loss of life, but also to a future of peace & reconciliation. The school raised £100 for the British Legion. On Sunday the school laid a wreath of poppies at the cenotaph as the local community gathered for Remembrance Sunday.

On Friday, students arrived at school in their own clothes as part of our efforts to fundraise for BBC's Children in Need. Three Year 11 students organised fundraising efforts this year, Jamie-Leigh Whittaker, Chloe Morris & Alex Forrester. Many thanks for taking the lead girls, & organising the day. Year 11 continue to 'Go for Gold' by attending Period 6 sessions nightly, extra lessons to help Year 11 in their studies. Our Year 11 theme is, 'Going for Gold', built on Team GB's success at the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

### **ST MARY'S CHURCH AND PRESBYTERY**

An Architect has been instructed to draw up plans for the permanent separation of the redundant Presbytery and for the eventual sale of it to developers for residential use, which will require the allocation of part of grounds and a form of access for the occupiers. Planning permission will be needed. The Diocese, who have agreed to the sale in principal, will need to agree the details. There will be an opportunity for the Parish to be consulted.

The intention is to use the proceeds of sale towards the maintenance of the Church long term. Grant Aid is also being sought to cover the cost of the design of the system to dispose of rainwater from the Church roof to prevent ingress of water, then to re-plaster & then to re-decorate. A building the size of St Mary's Church needs a lot of ongoing maintenance. Any Parishioners with expertise in managing building maintenance and ongoing health and safety issues are encouraged to step forward and give their help in this regard. Any such person should make their presence known to Father Greg please.
