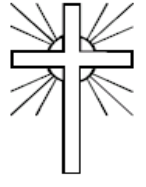

### **News from St Philip Howard Catholic Academy:**

This week we were lucky enough to secure 10 places for our Year 11's at a national conference in Maths and English. Held in Harrogate, the aim of the conference was to help some of our students to gain the all-important Grade 4 and 5 in the new GCSE's. Many of the pupils wanted to attend, but only 10 places were granted to schools who applied.

The conference followed up external mock exams completed at the end of February, helping students to overcome the 'Top 10' most common misconceptions or barriers to learners in English and Maths.

It was a long day for the pupils, but most beneficial.

One student said, 'The day particularly helped me in Maths, although the speed and pace of the conference was immense. It helped me to set out my work in Maths and to understand Maths problems more clearly'.
