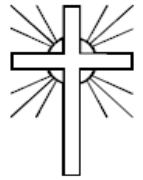

This is in addition to other building projects that include repairs to St Mary's Church Roof, Coping stones at front of St Mary Crowned Church, Dry rot on the corridor wall (SMC), Leaking ceiling in candle room (SMC), Damp wall/ceiling in the sacristy (SMC), Rebuilding the wall Tredcroft Street, Repairing the wall Sumner Street, Sale of Presbytery (SMC), Refurbishment of the Church (SMC), Underpinning Royle House Presbytery (All Saints).

## **Thoughts on Today's Gospel: Matthew 16 : 21-27**

Jesus has just chosen Simon Peter to be the leader of the apostles. He recognises the Father's choice of Simon by Simon's enlightenment in seeing who Jesus truly is - the Christ, the Son of God.

Immediately comes today's startling passage in which Simon Peter speaks above himself and is rebuked by Jesus, who calls him a Satan. Jesus says that to truly follow him is to carry one's cross.

This is the first time that Jesus speaks of his suffering and death and the glory of the Resurrection. On two other occasions he speaks similarly and each time the phrase used is that Jesus *will be raised* from the dead. In the same three places in Mark's gospel, however, the phrase is that Jesus *will rise* from the dead. We remember that St. Paul in his letters and the preaching of Peter in the Acts of the Apostles speak of Jesus being raised by God from the dead. Thus we have two early Christian understandings: Jesus rose from the dead (he was divine); Jesus was *raised* from the dead (by the Father's divine power).

Further, where Mark writes three times in the same passages, "after three days – Jesus will rise from the dead," in Matthew we read "on the third day Jesus would be raised from the dead." We become aware of the two understandings of the wonder of Jesus' resurrection - *being raised* and *rising*.
