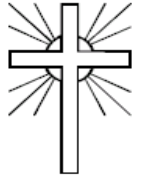

There is to be a major change in the Governance of all our Diocesan Catholic Schools from 1st September 2018.

Essentially all Diocesan Schools will become members of a multi academy trust (mat), with those schools who haven't yet converted, converting to voluntary academy status. For these schools, the consultation process will be taking place over the coming weeks; details of this can be found on each school's website and the NRCDES website (www.nottingham-des.org.uk).

The name given to the Derbyshire/ Staffordshire/Stockport mat is the St Ralph Sherwin Catholic multi academy trust, one of the forty martyrs of England and Wales, born in 1550 in Rodsley, Derbyshire. (FG)
