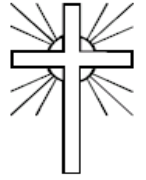

**There is to be a major change in the Governance of all our Diocesan Catholic Schools from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018.**

Essentially all Diocesan Schools will become members of a multi academy trust (mat), with those schools who haven't yet converted, converting to voluntary academy status.
