

## **Thoughts on Today's Readings:**

### **First Reading: Malachi 1:14 - 2:2, 8-10**

The name Malachi means "my messenger" and the name occurs at the opening of chapter 3. The book was written about 450 BC in order to encourage a demoralised people. The excitement of the return from Babylonian exile (534 BC) has long faded, the poor are oppressed by the rich, adultery and divorce have undermined family life, God seems not to care, and the worship and sacrifices of the priests are merely ritual. Spiritually, the people are dead.

But Malachi wants the people to know God has not forgotten them. The Lord has watched their sufferings, been angered by the religious and political shepherds who have failed the flock, and Malachi promises that the day of the Lord is coming when judgement will be made and righteousness rewarded.

Today's reading judges the priests who have failed the Lord and the people - through injustice, poor teaching and unworthy lives.
