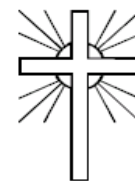

This is Holy Week – A week that changed the world. There will be additional confessions on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday this week 12Noon – 1pm, at All Saints Church. Thank you to Mgr. Jonathan Moore for this offer. There will be no confessions next Saturday. Let us enter together into the moving liturgies of the Sacred Triduum, and be with Jesus through his passion and death, culminating into the light overcoming the darkness at the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday! Maundy Thursday – Mass of the Lord's Supper and washing of the feet, 7pm at All Saints.

Good Friday – Is a day of fasting and abstinence, and the collection today will be for the Holy Places in the Holy Land. Cardinal Leonardo Sandri, head of the Vatican's Congregation for Eastern Churches has called on Catholics around the world to give generously to the Good Friday collection that traditionally goes to support the Church in the Holy Land. In an interview with the news agency of the Italian Bishops Conference (SIR) the Cardinal talks about the importance of contributing to the upkeep of the sacred sites, while at the same time supporting the search for peace in the land where Jesus lived. Faced with the events that "take place in this troubled region of the world", the Cardinal says, there is a risk that we see them as unconnected to our own lives, "as if we had no responsibility". But by taking part in this annual collection for the Holy Land, he says, Catholics can personally contribute to combatting "war, poverty, terrorism, violence, division".

The collection for the Holy Land has been supported by the different Popes over the decades, to "keep a strong bond between all Christians across the world and the Holy Places".

Beyond being a vital source of support for those holy places, the Cardinal adds, it is also "a tool that the Church has" to support the ecclesial communities of the broader Middle East region.

Children's Stations of the Cross – 10.30am, St Mary Crowned, then juice and Hot Cross buns.

Solemn Liturgy – 3pm, St Mary Crowned Church.

Adult Stations of the Cross – 7pm St Mary Crowned.

Easter Vigil – 8pm, All Saints Church

Easter Sunday Morning – 9.30 am – St Mary Crowned, and 11.00 am – All Saints Church.

It is not too late to be involved in these beautiful liturgies, according to the Liturgical instructions of the Church. If you would like to be more active please talk to any of the section leaders, or of course talk to me! (FG)

Mass of Chrism – Wednesday 28th March 11.30 am, St Barnabas' Cathedral Nottingham. Renewal of Religious /Priestly Vows by all Diocesan Deacons and Priests, and blessing of the Sacred Oils by Bishop Patrick McKinney to be used in every parish throughout the Diocese for the Sacraments. All are welcome. It is a very moving experience but I advise you to get there early to ensure a seat! (FG)

Lenten Ecumenical Project This week we complete our prayer and breakfast project with our brothers and sisters in Christ from other traditions. The final session is at St Andrews Hadfield on Wednesday at 7.15am (FG)

Extensive Repair work is being done at St Mary Crowned Church at the moment. The focus is at the far end of the Church (the apse) where there has been a problem with water ingress from the roof into the Church. This is visible when you see the damage to the plaster on the Sanctuary. The roof and drainage system have been re-designed to solve this problem and the work will cost over £70,000.

The maintenance of both Churches is expensive and ongoing, and I want to thank you for your generosity with the weekly collection. However, it does help us to manage the finances more efficiently knowing how much is coming in week on week. To this end, please remember your Church in your wills, consider joining the planned giving scheme, or setting up a standing order to the parish and if at all possible gift aiding it.
