A wonderful opportunity to pray peacefully before the Blessed Sacrament; this practice was originally introduced by St Charles Borromeo in Milan. Please do take an hour to join with our neighbouring parish in prayer this coming week.

<u>Thoughts from today's Second reading:</u> <u>St Paul's Letter to the Romans 8: 14-17</u>

This passage echoes today's first reading: we are the children of God. As God's children we may pray as Jesus did in the Garden of Gethsemene "Abba, Father," because we share his spirit.

The powerful word "adoption" reminds us of the practice common in the Roman world of families adopting a son when there was no heir to the property. Our glorious inheritance is to share eternal life as adopted children.

The Holy Spirit brings us into a new relationship with God who loves all peoples, but because we Christians know of that love given through Jesus in the Holy Spirit – we know we can return love to the God who gives love. We have no superiority over other human beings: but we are blessed to know and love God in a personal relationship.

In chapters 5, 6 and 7 Paul has looked at Sin and Death and the Law: in chapter 8 he brings us to the new life in the Spirit.

We pray to the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit. "Through Him, with Him, in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all glory and honour is yours, for ever and ever"
