# Thoughts from today's Readings:

The Old Testament prophets spoke to and on behalf of the people. Because they were human they knew human weaknesses in themselves. They, too, failed. But Jesus was sinless - in spite of sharing our weaknesses; he knew what we might be tempted to do, but in his conquering of sin he shows us the way. We look to him for mercy and help in time of need. God, who spoke through the prophets, has now spoken through the Son. The Word of God is alive and active.
