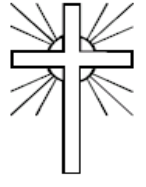

Fatima Message Talk

There will be a 30-minute Fatima-Marian talk at St Paul's Church on Sunday 26th May at 7 pm, immediately after the Ordinariate Mass at 6pm. The talk will be by Donal Foley, from the World Apostolate of Fatima, England and Wales, the official Fatima organisation approved by the Church. It will look at the Fatima message in the light of Marian devotion generally, and the very important place that the Church has traditionally given to Our Lady.

There will be free Fatima literature available, and some Fatima books and booklets for sale.

Walsingham Pilgrimage:

This year's Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham is on Saturday 15th June 2019.

Writing - Well is a unique creative writing course that combines the rigour of learning to write creative prose and poetry, delivered by a lecturer in English and published poet, with therapeutic input from a qualified counsellor/ life coach. The course is designed specifically to destigmatise mental health and to encourage participants to maintain the self-help tools that journaling, mindfulness, gratitude & being able to express emotions through words can deliver.

It is framed by the [5 ways to wellbeing](#), enabling participants to connect with new friends, get active and journal in their daily lives, take greater notice of their world, keep learning and give their words and support to each other, family and friends.

The course runs for five weeks from Monday 17th June at 2 - 4pm at the Volunteer Bureau Glossop.

Thoughts from today's Gospel Reading, Jn 14:23-39

Jude has just asked a question. Who is Jude, we ask. The brother of James or the son of James, we seem to discover as we chase his name through the Gospel accounts. If he is brother, he is also related to Matthew and to Alphaeus (Clopas, disciple on the road to Emmaus) and is thus related to Jesus

Why would it be remembered that Jude asked the question? It reads like a storyteller's device, to break or vary the flow of the narrative: but it is a Gospel moment, witnessed by an apostle. We glimpse John's disciples remembering John's recollecting this tiny detail - as he does a number of other details in the course of the Gospel.

Today's deep passage has four parts: love of God means to act on Christ's words; the Holy Spirit will come as teacher and guide; Christ's peace is ours always - do not be afraid; be glad for Jesus who is returning to his Father. © Watermead Apostolate
