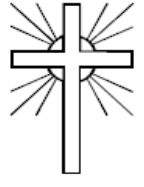

Thoughts from today's Gospel Reading, Mt 16: 13-19

Here is a defining moment in the story of Jesus and his ministry. Until now the Gospel has been about the coming of the Kingdom of God, but from now on Jesus begins to speak of his destiny to suffer and die.

The incident takes place at Caesarea Philippi, near the source of the River Jordan, and is the only Gospel moment recorded to take place there.

Mark and Luke also record Peter's profession of faith, but not the promise of Jesus that Peter is chosen as the foundation of the Church.

Scholars suggest that this commission was given after the Resurrection - but is placed here by Matthew for dramatic effect: the choice is implied by the Father's revealing to Peter who Jesus is, but was made explicit after the Resurrection.

*The truth is the choice –
the moment of its revelation something to ponder.*

We glimpse Jesus' prayer "Father, guide me to choose which of the apostles "and we sense his joy..

"Blessed are you, Simon .. ."
