

Fr Martin writes:

Our prayers are asked for the repose of the soul of Donald Frain, who died recently. May his soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Mr Frain's funeral will be celebrated, God willing, at St Mary Crowned at 10.30am on Friday 20th March.

Planning ahead:

Every third year, when we use cycle "A" of the Sunday readings, the Gospel readings towards the end of Lent are longer than usual. Fr Martin asks that people who find it difficult to stand should not feel at all embarrassed if they have to sit down before the Gospel reading is finished.

Next Sunday (22nd), God willing, parishioners at the 9.15am Mass will have the joy of celebrating a Mass with a baptism. Enza Pia Fulchini Willis is due to be baptised at this Mass.

This will naturally make the 9.15am Mass significantly longer than usual, and so Fr Daniel has kindly agreed to celebrate the 11.15am Mass at All Saints so people there don't experience a delayed starting time waiting for Fr Martin to arrive.
