Fr Martin writes,

It's that time of year when we remember with special devotion those of our loved ones who have died. May they rest on peace.

If I want my mum and dad, may they rest in peace, to have a share in every Holy Souls Mass offered in the year ahead, I put a note with their names, along with my offering, in one of the "Month of the Holy Souls November Dead List" envelopes. If I want them to have one Holy Mass offered for the repose of their souls, then I use the ordinary Mass Offering envelope, the type that is printed with a space for names to be written on the outside of the envelope.

It is perfectly fine to use an ordinary envelope, giving clear instructions, for example, "My offering for Holy Souls Masses. Please include [names] RIP in all the Holy Souls Masses" or "My offering for Holy Mass to be offered for the repose of the soul of [name] RIP."

Envelopes should be returned to Royle House, Church Street, Glossop SK13 7RJ.

People can also go online to arrange Mass offerings or add names to the Holy Souls list. Please visit paypal.me/fathermartin and use the form of words that is recommended above when using an ordinary envelope. When you work your way through the simple steps to submit your offering, do not tick "paying for goods or a service" -- we never pay for Holy Mass! The price of every Mass ever celebrated was paid by Jesus Christ with his Precious Blood on Calvary. Our offering for a Mass is a gift to cover, or at least contribute to, the priest's expenses for the day he offers Holy Mass for our requested intention.

Fr Martin writes,

I was very pleased to receive an email commenting positively on the implementation of Covid Secure arrangements at St Mary Crowned. Here's a brief extract:

"Excellent Compliance by parishioners. All parishioners were excellent in compliance with the COVID-19 Secure requirements, respecting distancing, mask wearing, hand hygiene and leaving without discussion or delay at the end. They were very respectful to the stewards. Additionally, it was beautiful to see people in discussions outside church after Mass, obviously respecting distancing. The good weather helped I am sure."

I know that our stewards in both churches are very appreciative, as am I, of the patient cooperation from people who come to take part in Holy Mass: thank you! Thanks again, too, to all those who helped with setting up the churches and producing the risk assessments and other documentation we submitted to gain permission to open for private prayer and Holy Mass, and to all our stewards, without whose generosity we would simply have to keep the churches closed.

REMEMBERING OUR LOVED ONES:

Whether or not we are able to be present at Mass in these strange times, we may be comforted that the names of our loved ones can be there before the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

Throughout November there will be a large candle on the Sanctuary of both churches with the names of all those connected to our parishes, who have died in the last twelve months. The candles will then remain at the front of the church until after Christmas.

Families, please ask any member of the PPC to let Maddy know of any names that need to be added to those taken from the Register of Deaths in each church. Also let her know if for any reason you prefer that a name is not added to the candle.

Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. **Amen**
