Lent begins this Wednesday, March 2nd

Pope Francis announces 2nd March as a day of prayer and fasting for Ukraine:

Pope Francis has made a heartfelt appeal for peace in Ukraine, saying that the threat of war had caused "great pain in my heart", and has announced a "Day of Fasting for Peace" on Ash Wednesday.

He Said "I encourage believers in a special way to dedicate themselves intensely to prayer and fasting on that day. May the Queen of Peace preserve the world from the madness of war."
