Good News from Saint Mary's CVA

We are delighted to share the report from our recent Catholic Schools Inspectorate (CSI) inspection with the parish. We are absolutely thrilled with it and immensely proud of all the children, staff and school community.

Overall the school achieved a grading of Good, with Catholic Life and Mission and Collective Worship deemed as Outstanding in all areas. Particular thanks go to Mrs Rudd and Mrs Thorne-Marsh for their dedication in leading this area. Whilst the report is very comprehensive, and we hope you get a chance to read it, here are some of the wonderful findings that were highlighted by the inspection team.

"Pupils' behaviour throughout all aspects of school is praised as being exemplary and it was acknowledged that children embrace and benefit from the many opportunities for pupil leadership they have.

"The inspectors determined that Saint Mary's is a welcoming and inclusive school, which lives out its mission statement in an outstanding manner and that furthermore, staff are excellent role models for all offering the highest quality leadership and pastoral support.

"Standards in Religious Education have risen markedly since the last inspection, which is testament to quality teaching and strong relationships and that the school is innovative in deepening children's faith and in also, raising their aspirations.

"Pupils show pride in their work and their school experience is enhanced by opportunities for prayer and liturgy. They show reverence at all time, are eager to share their understanding and their singing is joyful.

"There are close links with the parish through the celebration of Mass and the new parish ambassadors being drawn from the pupil body. There is a strong sense of community prevalent and children willingly involve themselves in action to care for the needy through their charitable and voluntary actions."

We are sure you will agree that this is a wonderful report to receive.
