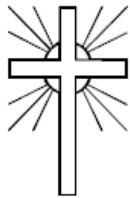

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY 2023 – 4th JUNE

Fr Martin writes,

Our prayers are asked for the repose of the soul of Margot Hawke, who died recently. *May her soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.*

The funeral of Mrs Hawke is expected to be celebrated, God willing, at All Saints Church on the morning of Friday 7th July.

Today is Trinity Sunday, when we celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity, one God in three persons.

All the official prayers of the Church, including the Holy Mass and the Sacraments, begin with an address to the Holy Trinity:

"In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

We are baptised, absolved of our sins and anointed in the name of the Blessed Trinity. Throughout the world, where church bells ring three times a day they invite Christians to pray to God the Father (the Provider); God the Son (the Saviour); and God the Holy Spirit (the Sanctifier). We bless ourselves with the Sign of the Cross invoking the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and we conclude our prayers glorifying the Holy Trinity, saying:

"Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit."

Today's readings convey the fundamental mystery that the Triune God reaches out to people in love, seeking the deepest communion with them.
