Mass arrangements on Wednesdays:

Following the recent parish survey, this week we begin our new Wednesday Mass arrangement, with a 'Holy Hour' on Wednesday evenings at All Saints. We will starting with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 7pm, and continue with Holy Mass at 7.30pm.

This arrangement will allow people who work during the day to attend a weekday Mass.

This Thursday, 19th October, we celebrate a commemoration of St Philip Howard,

St Philip Howard is one of the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales. Philip was the earl of Arundel and Surrey and was a zealous Catholic in the midst of Elizabethan England. Arrested by authorities, he was placed in the Tower of London in 1585 and condemned to death in 1589. The sentence was never carried out, and Philip died in the Tower at the age of thirty eight. Beatified in 1929, he was included among the English martyrs canonized in 1970 by Pope Paul VI. The pupils and staff of St Philip Howard CVA will be attending Mass this Thursday to celebrate his commemoration.

Next Sunday, 22nd October, is World Mission Sunday, when the Holy Father invites all
Catholics to contribute to a special collection for *Missio*, his charity for world mission.
