CAFOD has some big news about the Fix the Food System campaign!

This past summer, over 80 signatures from our parishes, with those of over 70,000 other parishioners, supported Salina's letter calling on the World Bank to protect farmers' rights to freely access their traditional seeds.

The letters were handed to the Director of Global Food Practice at their annual meeting. As a result of this the World Bank has agreed to meet with CAFOD representatives in both London and Morocco and has started to look at the issue. This is an important step forward in this campaign, and CAFOD want to pass on a big thanks to you all.
