## A reflection from Pope Francis for the Year of Prayer, for the Third Sunday of the Year:

If during prayer we feel sluggish and empty, we must at that moment bea that Jesus' prayer also become our own. "I cannot pray today, I don't know what to do: I don't feel like it, I am unworthy". In this moment Jesus is before the Father, praying for us; let us trust in this! If we are trustful, we will then hear a voice from heaven, "You are God's beloved, you are a child, you are the joy of the Father in heaven".
