A Prayer for the Second Sunday of Lent.

God, heavenly Father, look upon me and hear my prayer during this holy Season of Lent. By the good works You inspire, help me to discipline my body and to be renewed in spirit. Without You I can do nothing.

This Lent we are offering:

- Lent Solemn Vespers The evening prayer of the church – at All Saints Church each Sunday during Lent at 5.30pm, until approximately 6pm.
- **Stations of the Cross** Each Friday during Lent at St Mary's Church at 6pm until approx. 7pm.

Ask your MP to support the abortion time limit reduction amendment: Please support an amendment to reduce our abortion time limit from 24 weeks to 22 weeks. Research indicates that a significant number of babies born at 22 or 23 weeks can now survive outside the womb, leaving a contradiction in our abortion law.
