- Creating our 5-year plan; the objectives for the first year will come out of our identified 'threats', and these were summarised as:
 - > Fr Martin being moved, although recent moves of priests within the diocese has been limited
 - > Lack of volunteers, objective here to identify and develop new volunteers and to pray for them
 - Succession planning, objective here to further develop existing volunteers while accepting and encouraging different approaches and occasional errors
 - Complacency
 - Disappointment with any perceived lack of interest in the efforts to date
 - The health of key individuals

The development of the 5-year plan will be our main focus for the coming year
