Confirmation gives us a special **strength** of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by **word and action** as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and **never to be ashamed** of the Cross.

Bishop Patrick writes,

"Today is Safeguarding Sunday, an opportunity to reflect a little on our ongoing journey as a diocese to build a safer environment for every person. You will recall that the Elliott review in 2020 recommended that the Catholic Church in England and Wales put in place a national Safeguarding body.

In July 2021 the Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency was formed. Its task is to ensure that all dioceses are regulated to meet the national standards in Safeguarding.

As a diocese, we have worked well to develop clear structures and guidance for our Safeguarding practices so as to help ensure safe environments through the promotion of best practice. This has included, regular training in Safeguarding for the clergy, diocesan staff and parish volunteers; ensuring that everyone is safely recruited; that victims and survivors are carefully listened to and supported, and that we are always transparent and accountable in the way that allegations and concerns are managed effectively.

I welcome this opportunity to thank our central Safeguarding team, Rachael Campion, Alan Booth and Jane Black, for all their good work. I would also like to express my gratitude to the parish Safeguarding Representatives for their hard work and commitment. Through them, we are now embedding excellent Safeguarding practices across our parishes and chaplaincies to make our churches safe and welcoming."

We will be speaking to you at the end of Mass today updating you on the safeguarding developments in our diocese, as well everything we have done during the last year towards ensuring that our churches offer a safe environment for all members of our church communities.
