Today we celebrate World Communications Day

Shortly after his election to the papacy, Pope Leo held an audience with the men and women who were in Rome to report on the death of Pope Francis, the conclave, and the first days of his own ministry.

He thanked the media professionals for their work, and his address included a call for communication to foster peace by caring for how people and events are presented, and invited them to promote communication that "does not seek consensus at all costs, does not use aggressive words, does not follow the culture of competition, and never separates the search for truth from the love with which we must humbly seek it." He added "The way we communicate is of fundamental importance,"

Pope Leo concluded by repeating Pope Francis' Message for the World Day of Communication.

*"Let us disarm communication of all prejudice and resentment, fanaticism and even hatred...
"Let us disarm words, and we will help disarm the world."*
