News from the Vatican

Pope Leo XIV will canonize Blesseds Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati together this Sunday September 7th.

Blessed Carlo Acutis was known for his devotion to the Eucharist and creating an online exhibition of Eucharistic miracles.

Born in 1991 and raised in Milan he used his technical skills to evangelise and was noted for his joyful faith and compassion for others before dying of leukemia in 2006 aged 15.

Blessed Frassati, born in 1901 in Turin was admired for his deep spirituality, his love for the poor and enthusiasm for life. A member of the Dominican Third Order, he served the sick through the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

He died at age 24 after contracting polio, possibly from one of the people he assisted.

The two Italian laymen will be the first saints proclaimed by the new pope.

The Emergency Alerts system is used to warn if there's a danger to life nearby, including extreme weather. The UK government is testing the Emergency Alerts system on **Sunday 7th September 2025 at 3pm**. Your mobile phone or tablet will vibrate and make a loud siren-like sound, even if it's set on silent. The alert message will confirm this is a test and that you do not need to take any further action.

Regular testing ensures the system is functioning correctly, should it need to be used in a life-threatening emergency. Only the government and the emergency services are able to send these alerts. Find out more at gov.uk/alerts.
