Fr Martin writes, RIP

Our prayers are asked for the repose of the soul of Mike Lynch, who died recently. May his soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. The funeral of Mr Lynch is expected to be celebrated, God willing, at St Mary Crowned at 10.30am on Wednesday 29th October.

On World Mission Sunday, the whole Church unites in prayer and generosity to support Catholic communities across the world facing poverty, conflict, and hardship. This year's World Mission Sunday is being celebrated this Sunday, 19th October, and Pope Francis chose 'Missionaries of Hope Among All Peoples' as this year's theme, reminding us of our call to be messengers and builders of hope in this Jubilee Year.
