He is a leading expert on the Shroud of Turin, the cloth that many believe was the one which wrapped Jesus after he died. He gave a fascinating account of the dating evidence revealed by over a hundred years of research. He highlighted the evidence that supports the shrouds authenticity and critically investigated the results of the various testing which had suggested the shroud was not authentic.
