### Magnifica Humanitas

*The Diocese shares, the first Encyclical Letter of The Holy Father Leo XIV, 'Magnifica Humanitas' on safeguarding the human person in the time of Artificial Intelligence, was launched this week. Magnifica Humanitas offers insights into the protection of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence, recognising a profound epochal shift. It places the dignity of the human person at the centre as the criteria for guiding technical progress. The Church's social teaching accompanies these transformations, pointing to the common good, solidarity and subsidiarity as the fundamental benchmarks for understanding and interpreting the transformation currently underway. It proposes, as an alternative to the culture of power and war, a civilisation of love founded on justice, dialogue and shared responsibility. The Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development have produced explanatory infographics and a video presentation for Magnifica Humanitas which are a useful starting point to accessing and understanding the Encyclical.
