### Catholic Schools Inspectorate

*Mrs Grainne Beaumont, Executive Headteacher, writes*, I am delighted to share with you the outcome of our recent CSI inspection which took place at All Saints school at the start of May.

There are three main sections to an inspection: 'Catholic Life' - how faithfully the school responds to the call to live as a Catholic community at the service of the Church's educational mission; 'Religious Education' - the quality of curriculum religious education RE and 'Collective Worship' - the quality and range of liturgy and prayer provided by the school.

We were rated Good or Outstanding in all areas. The report details "What the school does well:

- Leaders are deeply committed to providing the best possible Catholic education for the benefit of all pupils and their families.
- Pupils show a high degree of respect for each other, and for those beyond the school, as exemplified by their willingness to provide service that benefits others.
- There is a strong sense of community, of a united family, marked by the inclusivity and welcome of all.
- Staff are fully committed to the importance of religious education; this results in the high engagement and clear enjoyment of pupils.
- Pupils are confident and enthusiastic in planning and leading celebrations of the word; they take their responsibilities seriously."
