Catholic Life in Glossop

Father Martin writes, as announced in last week's newsletter, Bishop Patrick has decreed that from 8th September, the two parishes in Glossop will merge into one, to be known as the Parish of Blessed Nicholas Garlick, Glossop. Anniversary of the Consecration of St Mary Crowned

Father Kevin Athaide, Diocesan Archivist, has kindly shared with us, Father Dolan has made a note in 'Good News for the East Midlands' to say that Mgr. Bagshawe (our third Bishop) laid the foundation stone at St Mary Crowned, Glossop on the third day of July, 1886, and that the church was 'solemnly opened' on the eighteenth day of August, 1887, when the choir sang Haydn's First Mass with a 'full band.'

Eucharistic Adoration
